CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm by Mayor Moore. Mayor Moore stated that the purpose of the meeting was a Public Hearing on the budget.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all present.

INVOCATION:

The Invocation was given by Vice-Mayor Greer.

CITIZEN INPUT:

Mr. Miles informed the Mayor and Council that there was no one signed up to speak. He said that they should wait about ten minutes and if no one shows up then they could close the Public Hearing. Donald E. Kellam, Jr. addressed the Mayor and Council in reference to the salaries and overtime in the budget. He said that he realizes that with public works there are emergencies from time to time and some overtime should be allowed for but feels 1040 hours of overtime is excessive. Mr. Kellam noted also that the 40 hours of overtime for the administration is reasonable. He said that the water and wastewater fees in expenditures are out of balance and feels that it is partly due to the overtime being paid in public works.

MOTION TO ADJOURN:

Councilman Scanlan made the Motion to adjourn the Public Hearing. The Motion was seconded by Councilman Metz. The Motion was passed unanimously. The Public Hearing was adjourned.

Councilman Scanlan made the Motion to hold a special meeting to vote on the 2013 budget on Monday, June 25, 2012 at 7:00. Discussion-None. Mr. Miles noted that he would like to add a consideration for a Resolution to opt out of the Line of Duty Act coverage with VRS and go with

VML. He noted that the Council passed the Resolution at the last meeting but VRS wants their own Resolution which is more involved than his version. Councilman Scanlan amended his Motion to include the Resolution for VRS to be included in next week's special meeting. There was no further discussion. The Motion was passed unanimously

Mayor Moore stated that this concludes the Public Hearing and they have a special Council Meeting to follow which requires them to convene to Closed Session.
