CALL TO ORDER:

The Public Hearing was called to order at 6:00 pm by Mayor Greer. Mayor Greer established a
quorum.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:

PUBLIC HEARING – PROPOSED 2015 BUDGET:

Mr. Duer noted that no one had signed up to speak. Mayor Greer asked if anyone had any
comments.

Revell Walker commented on the need for a Skate Park. Mayor Greer said that he would like to
meet with Mr. Duer and Mr. Walker. Mr. Duer said that we will check on liability insurance.

He highlighted the wastewater expense, noting that as in previous years, it is over two times greater
than the income. Mr. Duer said that the deficit is less than last year but we still need more users.

Mr. Duer commented on the budget photos. He noted that the photos of the employees were
included because our employees are valuable to us, we need to invest in them he anticipates no turn
over this year.
