

Ordinance No. 192

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF EXMORE TO AMEND AND
RE-ENACT ORDINANCE NO. 50,
“PUNISHMENT FOR MISDEMEANOR”

The Town Council of Exmore, of the County of Northampton, Commonwealth of Virginia, ordains as follows:

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 50 of the Town of Exmore provides for the imposition of fines for violations of any ordinances of the Town of Exmore for which no punishment is prescribed; and

WHEREAS, the schedule of fines in Ordinance No. 50 is out of date,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Exmore, Virginia that Ordinance No. 50 of the Town of Exmore is amended and re-enacted as follows:

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Exmore that any person convicted of a misdemeanor for violation of any ordinance of the Town of Exmore, for which no punishment is prescribed in said ordinance, or for which punishment is prescribed in accordance with this ordinance, shall be punished by a fine of not less than One Dollar (\$1.00), nor more than Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00), and costs.
